#### **PURPOSE OF JOB:**

All positions at The Protestant Separate School Board of the Town of Penetanguishene support the Board's priority of providing an educational environment that encourages all students to achieve their full potential spiritually, academically, physically, and socially in preparation toward becoming contributing members of society.

The purpose of the 1.0 FTE Teacher position is to contribute at Burkevale Protestant Separate School, commencing February 2022, in a class or classrooms where a teaching need has been identified.

#### **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Duties assigned to the Teacher under Regulation 298 of the *Education Act*;
- Work with school staff to provide guidance, emotional support, and encouragement to all students, providing opportunities for successfully fostering self-esteem and promoting positive peer and adult interaction;
- Prepare materials in preparation for programs as required by the School Team;
- Liaise with multi-disciplinary services within as well as outside of the School Board;
- Implement modified programs to allow students to develop meaningful academic and social skills within the school and community;
- Carry out specific programs in language, behaviour management, and physical management as established by the IPRC process and/or IEP;
- Accompany and support students in the community during excursions;
- Attend appropriate meetings as requested by the Principal;
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Principal.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED:**

- Hold a Certificate of Registration in Good Standing with the Ontario College of Teachers (OCT);
- Primary/Junior Qualifications.

### **CERTIFICATIONS OF ASSET:**

- Strong understanding and implementation of Ontario Curriculum;
- Sound knowledge of evidence-based assessment practices and early intervention strategies;
- Familiarity with various computer applications/programs, etc.;
- Experience in teaching online and in-person;
- High level of emotional intelligence and strong professional collaboration;
- Experience working with First Nations, Métis, Inuit (FNMI) students;
- Excellent interpersonal skills in dealing with children, adolescents, and families.

### **CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT:**

- New employees to the PSSBP are required, by legislation, to submit a satisfactory Criminal Record and Vulnerable Sector Check;
- The 1.0 FTE Teacher Long-Term Occasional position is a member of the Elementary Teachers' Federation of Ontario (ETFO), and further details of employment will be subject to the current Teaching Employees' Collective Agreement that is in place.
