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POLICY STATEMENT

The Education Act s.176 (4) empowers the Board to make available an Accident Insurance Program for students. It shall be the policy of the Protestant Separate School Board of the Town of Penetanguishene (PSSBP) to provide parents/guardians of students with an opportunity to purchase student accident insurance annually on a voluntary basis.

PURPOSE

To provide, by contract with an insurer under the Insurance Act, an option for parents/guardians to purchase accident insurance for their child(ren).

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES

The PSSBP understands that some injuries incur medical, dental or other expenses that may not be covered by provincial health care or employer group plans.

- 1. A copy of the student accident insurance policy and an application form shall be made available to each student annually through the school's administration.
- 2. The provision of student accident insurance shall be made available only as a service to parents/guardians for their child(ren), and not as an endorsement of the particular policy.
