POLICY STATEMENT

The Protestant Separate School Board of the Town of Penetanguishene (PSSBP) and Burkevale Protestant Separate School will exercise rights, as permitted under the Education Act s. 304 and under Regulation 262 of the Education Act (PPM108), acknowledging the denominational identity and cultural and historical roots of both the Board and the School.

PURPOSE

To provide direction for Burkevale Protestant Separate School regarding the duty to engage in daily Morning Exercises

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES

- 1. Morning exercises will be conducted each and every school morning and will consist of:
 - a) the Canadian National Anthem (O Canada);
 - b) a reading that may be chosen from Christian Scripture, religious prayers, or other religious-based writings;
 - c) the Lord's prayer;
 - d) Land Acknowledgement;
 - e) announcements for the day
- 2. Parents who object to all or part of the exercises may apply to the principal to have their child(ren) exempted.
