PM Description: The Mental Health and Well-Being and Multi-Disciplinary Team Lead will provide the afternoon Professional Development (PD) around culturally responsive trauma-informed principles, information about sexual abuse prevention and reporting, and staff obligations and requirements under Erin's Law.

All staff will complete a refresher in WHMIS before the end of the day and sign off on the completion of all health and safety training.
